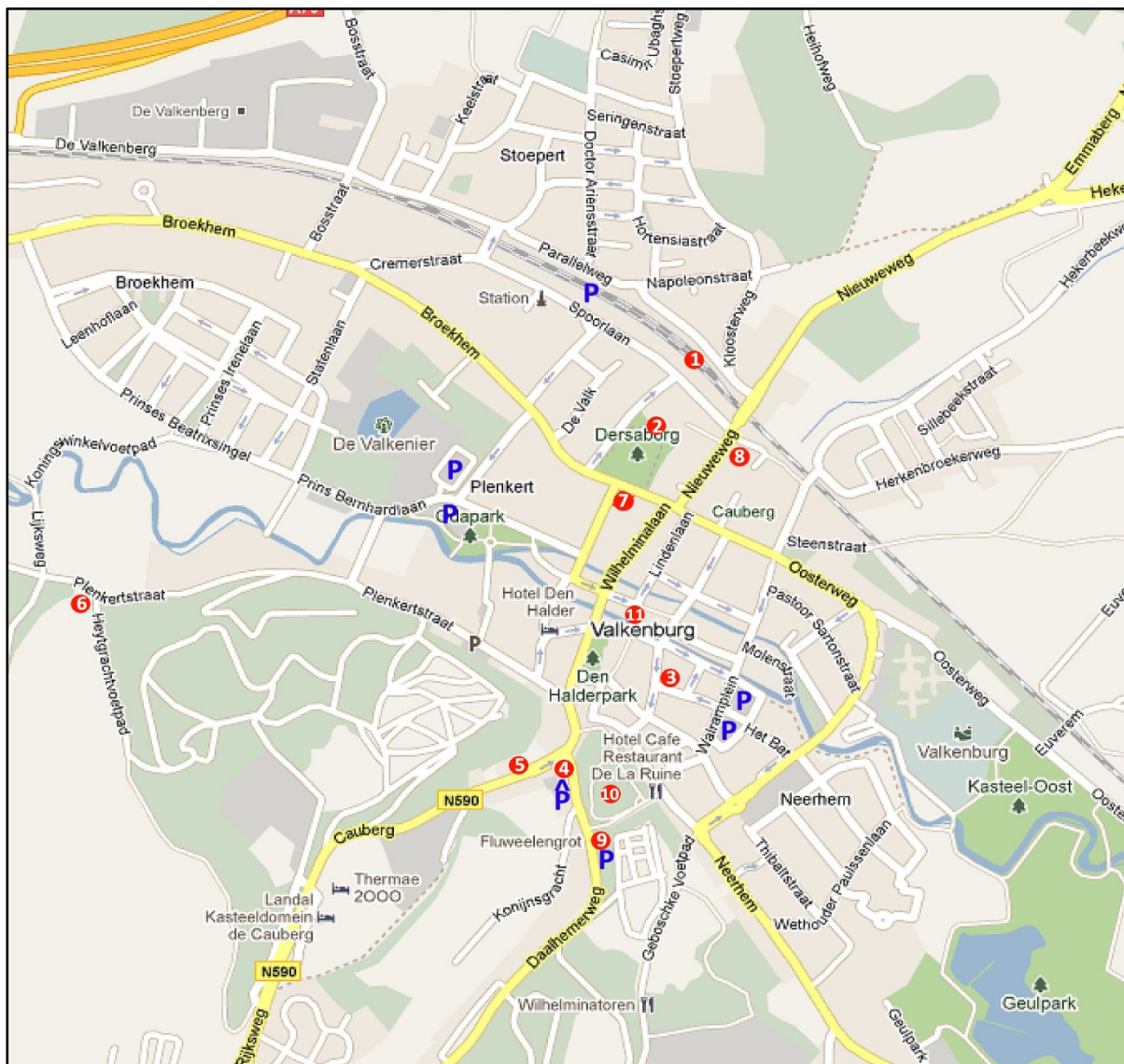


Program of the 6th International Symposium on archaeological Mining History
